Uprising: the October Rebellion in Ecuador tells the story of the October 2019 indigenous uprising in Ecuador that brought to prominence Leonidas Iza, President of the Confederation of Indigenous Nationalities of Ecuador (CONAIE), and the best-known of a new generation of Indigenous leaders in Ecuador. The movement demands action on the climate crisis and destruction of the natural environment for profit and calls for an alternative to neoliberal economics. It is now published for the first time in English and its authors Leonidas Iza, Andres Tapia and Andres Madrid are visiting Scotland to promote the book and build links with climate and trade union activists.

At **8pm Wednesday 12 July 7pm**, Leonidas Iza will address the opening rally of **Climate Camp Scotland near Grangemouth** (approximately four miles from Falkirk, 25 miles from Glasgow/Edinburgh, 50 miles from Dundee).
